May 10, 2012

Today you board your international flight for Barcelona, Spain!

May 11, 2012

After arriving in Barcelona this morning you'll be assisted with your luggage and then transferred to your hotel. After checking in, you'll have time to relax and freshen up before enjoying dinner in Barcelona on your own.

May 12, 2012

Enjoy a leisurely breakfast this morning before setting out on a city tour of beautiful Barcelona, capital of Catalonia. With its magnificent Gothic cathedral and Antoni Gaudí's spectacular architecture, this city is like no other! May 13, 2012

You'll arrive in delightful Sanary-sur-Mer, France this morning at 9:00 a.m. and have a full day to explore. This petite, carefree fishing village is where the French vacation. May 15, 2012

Another full day of exploring the hilly Provencal countryside awaits as you dock in Saint-Tropez, France from 8 a.m. to 11p.m. Charming villages abound with their narrow stepped streets, lovely churches and stunning scenic views! Along the way, perhaps stop in at a local winery or simply enjoy the spectacle of Saint-Tropez, where people watching has been taken to a new art. *(B/L/D)*

May 16, 2012

Sophisticated Monte Carlo, Monaco is your next stop, arriving at 8 a.m. Enjoy a stroll through the Old City and visit the Prince's Palace of Monaco where the state rooms are open to the public. And of course a visit to Monte Carlo wouldn't be complete without stopping in the famous Casino. Return to your ship in time for an 11 p.m. departure. *(B/L/D)*

May 17, 2012

Portofino, Italy is a picturesque seaside village with colorful pastel houses lining the shore of the harbor. You'll dock here from 8 am to 6pm, so you will have ample time to explore her shops and cafes. Then you might visit Santa Margherita, with its palm lined harbor and friendly ambience, perhaps enjoying a meal and cocktail in one of the many cafes surrounding her Piazza. *(B/L/D)*

May 18, 2012

You'll have two full days for exploring Tuscany, docking over-night in Livorno! After arriving at 8 a.m., you'll depart, traveling through the rolling hills of Tuscany dotted with medieval hill towns on your way to the capital city of the Renaissance, Florence! Upon arrival your local guide will accompany you on a walking tour of Florence, including the magnificent Cathedral, the Duomo and the neighboring Baptistery which boasts Ghiberti's exquisite bronze doors. Inside the Duomo, you'll marvel at the architectural techniques used by Brunelleschi to build the massive dome, the largest of its time. Then, you'll head for the Accademia for a visit to the museum that houses the famous work by Michelangelo, the statue of David! The afternoon is free to do some shopping in Florence where leather goods are a specialty, and the perfect spot to pick up a beautiful leather bag or jacket. You'll then return to Livorno to enjoy dinner aboard the Marina. *(B/L/D)*

May 19, 2012

This morning you'll meander through the beautiful rolling hills of Tuscany. As you embark on another exclusive TRIPS shore excursion, you'll visit Pisa and marvel at her famous leaning tower, the round white marbled Baptistery and the Piazza dei Cavalieri, once the center of the republic of Pisa. 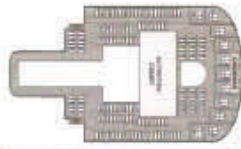

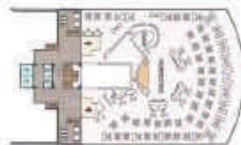
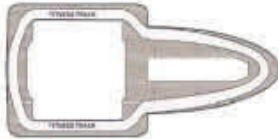
Marina DECK PLANS
